



Third-Party Fundraising Policy

The purpose of this policy is to provide clear guidance regarding fundraising activities at ILM Center, while honoring our commitment to responsible stewardship, transparency, and care for our community.

Policy Statement

To ensure the sustainability of our mission and the responsible management of our resources, **ILM Center will not permit third-party individuals, groups, or organizations to conduct fundraising activities at our facilities or during our programs.** This includes fundraising conducted on-site, during services or events, or using the organization's name, space, or resources.

This policy is guided by the following considerations:

- **Stewardship:** Our primary responsibility is to meet the financial and operational needs of our own community and programs.
- **Clarity & Trust:** A consistent approach ensures transparency and avoids confusion for congregants, donors, and visitors.

This policy applies to all third-party fundraising efforts, including but not limited to:

- Soliciting donations or pledges during gatherings or events
- Collection of funds on organizational premises
- Use of organizational branding, mailing lists, or communication platforms for external fundraising
- Hosting fundraising events for outside causes or organizations

Requests for exceptions must be submitted in advance and will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Any exception must receive prior written approval from the Board of Directors or its designated authority.

This policy will be reviewed periodically by the Board of Directors and may be updated as circumstances and organizational needs evolve.
